Key learning objectives

What Will Be Explored & Experience

The curriculum begins what a Spred Circle that include activities that:

From here they are moved into the Creation Stations where they have the opportunity to explore what the lesson means to them through the use of art, drama games and/or food experiences.

Lesson I, "The Journey Begins," (Jesus Enters Jerusalem)
Focus: Exploring what is needed to prepare for a journey into new understanding.
Lesson 2, "The Inner Sanctuary," (The Temple Traders)
Focus: Understanding that our inner temple is sacred and when we turn to the Christ we can empty it of all that is not for our highest good.
Lesson 3, "One In Spirit," (The Washing of the Feet & The Last Supper)30
Focus: Understanding that we are all one in Spirit.
Lesson 4, "God is Always With Me," (The Garden of Gethsemane 38)
Focus: Understanding that no matter what difficulties we go is rough, God is always with us.
Lesson 5, "Seeing Beyond Appearances," (ex us is Arrested, Sentenced & Crucified)46
Focus: Understanding that long times love, understanding and forgiveness are what is necessary in order to rise above a challenge.
Lesson 6, "A Time of Awakening," (The Resurrection)
Focus: Understanding that the resurrection is a symbol of new life. As we look within, we reawakened to who we truly are - mind, body and soul.
Lesson 7, "Seeing With God-Eyes," (The Road to Emmaus)
Focus: Exploring the importance of recognizing our good when it shows up.
Lesson8, "IRise," (The Ascension)
Focus: Knowing that when we allow our Christ-self to guide us, we see challenges in a new light and we rise above them.
